Two Teens Charged for Injury To A Child in Car Window Shooting From December 2014

Date/Time: Sunday, December 14, 2014 @ 9:30 p.m.

Location: 6500 blk Westwind

Arrested 1: 19-year old Anthony Hunter RICE of 4800 blk Mesa, El Paso, TX

Arrested 2: 18-year old Theodore Habib AYOUB of 1100 blk Galloway, El Paso

EL PASO, TEXAS – Investigators assigned to the Westside Regional Command Center have arrested and charged two Westside teens with Injury To A Child as a result of a December 14, 2014 incident. The investigation revealed that Theodore AYOUB was driving a red Ford Taurus in the 6500 block of Westwind and Anthony RICE was riding inside the vehicle. RICE and AYOUB were working together when RICE fired a BB or pellet at a silver Jeep striking the Jeep's right rear door frame and right rear window. The window shattered and glass fragments from the window caused injury to a 2 year old that was inside the Jeep. AYOUB and RICE fled the scene and police were notified. Westside detectives obtained warrants of arrest for AYOUB and RICE for the offense of Injury To A Child and their bonds were set at \$100,000.00. Both teens have been booked in the El Paso County Detention Facility.
