El Paso International Airport Completes Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Inspection

EL PASO, TEXAS – El Paso International Airport (EPIA) completed its annual Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Certification inspection with no deficiencies.

The three-day inspection is a rigorous review covering all components of an airport’s ability to provide a safe operating facility for tenants and the traveling public.

“Receiving no deficiencies on the airport’s annual certification inspection is a very difficult goal to reach. The results are a testament to the hard work and dedication demonstrated by the aviation operations and maintenance staff as well as the El Paso Fire Department’s Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) group stationed at the airport,” said El Paso International Airport Director Monica Lombraña.

The inspection focused on employee training and documentation, ARFF, aircraft fueling procedures and fuel truck safety, safety during construction, the Airport Emergency Plan, and a thorough airfield evaluation.
