Lt. Hernandez introduced Sgt. Timmons whose presentation covered the SRO Program for YISD.

- Handouts provided covering the SRO program and its demographics.
- Individual schools can hire off duty officers as per their budgets above and beyond the SRO program. SROs deal with parents, teachers, administration, and conduct sessions on any issue that affects juveniles (e.g., drugs, assaults, bullying, etc.).
- State law forbids 6<sup>th</sup> grade or below from being arrested. State wants to put the punitive action back to the school.
- YISD is only district with EPPD officers involved with the schools, especially in the high school setting.
- Sgt. Timmons took questions from the audience (e.g., procedures for tasing juveniles).

Lt. Hernandez took over after presentation and shared information regarding MVRCC stats.

- Crime down by 6%
- MVRCC needs approximately 20 more officers to do an adequate job
- MVRCC is hardpressed
- Increase in beer runs
- Good working relations with law enforcement agency at Ft. Bliss MPs
- Panhandlers at intersections begging (law against begging or giving)
