Lt. Hernandez informed everyone that the guest speaker, Ofc. Mike Medina was involved in an accident and would not be available for the presentation. He further went on to state what the Special Operations group does;

- Focus on different areas each week (e.g., license checks, focusing on areas that are high maintenance. 80% of citations issued were based on NO insurance. Fines run about \$125 for this and those for cell phone misuse are over \$100.
- Speed checks are being initiated throughout the MVRCC
- Lt. Hernandez took input on school zone speeding
- Spring Break coming up which equals more police action/vigilance
- Graffiti problems seem to be down or, “not enough to target all the hot spots”
- Lt. Hernandez fielded numerous questions revolving around different public safety issues.
- Crime is down 15% in the MVRCC while most of the other regions are up.
