- Failure to yield the right of way to a pedestrian in crosswalk \$204.00 fine
- Jaywalking \$65.00 fine
- Passing in a school zone \$204.00 fine
- Stop sign violation in a crosswalk \$179.00 fine
- Walking against pedestrian control signal \$81.00 fine
- Skateboard riding on the roadway \$121.00 fine
- Disobeying the school crossing guard \$164.00 fine
- Overtaking a school bus \$229.00 fine
- Speeding in a school zone \$147.00 - \$317.75 fine
- Parking within 20 feet of a crosswalk \$52.00 fine
- Parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant \$52.00 fine
- Parking over 18 inches from the curb \$28.00 fine
- No parking/ no stopping/ no standing sign violation \$55.00 fine
- Handicapped parking violation \$275.00 fine
- Parking in front of a driveway \$52.00 fine
- Parking within 30 feet of a stop sign \$28.00 fine
- Seatbelt violation for children under 17 years of age \$253.00 fine
- Failure to properly secure vehicle (leaving the vehicle unattended and running) \$139.00 fine
