AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) CHAPTER 12.04 (GENERAL PROVISIONS AND DEFINITIONS); AND TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.80 (MISCELLANEOUS TRAFFIC REGULATIONS), SECTION 12.80.090 (DRIVING ON SIDEWALKS), OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE TO ALLOW FOR THE USE OF MOTOR ASSISTED SCOOTERS ON SIDEWALKS. THE PENALTY IS AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 12.84 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 551 of the Texas Transportation Code allows a municipality to prohibit the operation of a motor assisted scooter on a street, highway, or sidewalk if the governing body of the municipality determines that the prohibition is necessary in the interest of safety; and

WHEREAS, Title 12 of the El Paso City Code currently prohibits the use of vehicles on the public sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, new technologies allowing for dock-less shared use mobility devices have evolved; and

WHEREAS, some shared use mobility devices constitute motor assisted scooters; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that in the interest of public safety, a person should be allowed to use a motor assisted scooter outside of the portions of the streets designated for motor vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EL PASO:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic) Chapter 12.04 (General Provisions and Definitions) is amended to add a new Section 12.04.125 to read as follows:

12.04.125- Motor Assisted Scooter.

"Motor assisted scooter" means a self-propelled device with: (1) at least two wheels in contact with the ground during operation; (2) a braking system capable of stopping the device under typical operating conditions; (3) a gas or electric motor not exceeding 40 cubic centimeters; (4) a deck designed to allow a person to stand or sit while operating the device; and (5) the ability to be propelled by human power alone. This term does not include a moped, motorcycle, electric bicycle, motor-driven cycle, a motorized mobility device, a pocket bike, minimotorbike, electric personal assistive mobility device, or a neighborhood electric vehicle all of which are defined in the Texas Transportation Code.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic) Chapter 12.80 (Miscellaneous Traffic Regulations), Section 12.80.090- Driving on sidewalks is amended in its entirety to read as follows: 12.80.090 - Driving on sidewalks.

The driver of a vehicle shall not drive within any sidewalk area except at a permanent or temporary driveway. This prohibition does not apply to the driving of a motor assisted scooter as defined in this Title.
