BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

On November 5 2018, an initiative petition was filed with the City Clerk's Office related to the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zones Number 10 and 12 geographic areas.

Section 3.11 - Initiative of the City Charter requires that the petition verification and placement of the proposed ordinance be placed on the City Council agenda meeting to be held within 30 working days of the filing date of the petition.

Thus, pursuant to all applicable City Charter provisions and requirements, the City Clerk is presenting this petition to the City Council within the 30 working days specified.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

Ordinance 018790 adopted by City Council on May 29, 2018 designated a noncontiguous geographic area as Reinvestment Zone Number 12 and Ordinance 018791, which amended Ordinance 018749, expanded the boundaries of Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number 10
