Objectives

- Improve problematic conditions on neighborhood streets by implementing traffic calming measures
- Maximize safety for all roadway users through appropriate application of traffic calming devices and structures









Accessibility Considerations

- Upgrading existing sidewalks and curb ramps to directional curb ramps with detectable warning elements
- Curb extensions will provide a safer path of travel for pedestrians crossing the street at intersections.




Havenrock Dr (District #3) - Project Scope

- Havenrock from Yarbrough to Lee Trevino
 - <u>Install 4 curb extensions</u> on Havenrock at the following cross streets: Brookrock, Fierro, Kermit, and Lee Trevino
 - <u>Install a traffic circle</u> at Havenrock and Edgerock
 - <u>Install striping</u> to include edge lines, double yellow lines, and traffic circle marking
 - <u>Install appropriate signage</u>



Regulus Dr (District #4)






Regulus Dr (District #4) - Project Scope

- Regulus from McCombs to Railroad
 - <u>Install 4 curb extensions</u> on Regulus at the following cross streets: Agena, Sidewinder, Bomarc, and Vandenburg.
 - <u>Install a traffic circle</u> at Regulus and Titan
 - <u>Install striping</u> to include edge lines, double yellow lines, and traffic circle markings
 - <u>Install appropriate signage</u>






Round Rock Dr (District #4)





Round Rock Dr (District #4) - Project Scope

- Round Rock from Rushing to Lucy (near Kenworthy)
 - <u>Install 6 curb extensions</u> on Round Rock at the following cross streets: Pleasant Hill, Lemonade, Sugarland, Coral Sands, Pearl Sands, Fort Worth, and Lucy.
 - <u>Install striping</u> to include edge lines, double yellow lines, and other markings as needed
 - <u>Install appropriate signage</u>





Breckenridge Dr (District #5)





Breckenridge Dr (District #5) - Project Scope

- Breckenridge from Paducah to George Dieter
 - <u>Install 5 curb extensions</u> on Breckenridge at the following cross streets: Proud Eagle, Red Cloud, Wooster, Red Sails, and the cul-desac at the midpoint between the elbow on Breckenridge and Paducah.
 - <u>Install striping</u> to include edge lines, double yellow lines, and other markings as needed.
 - <u>Install appropriate signage</u>
