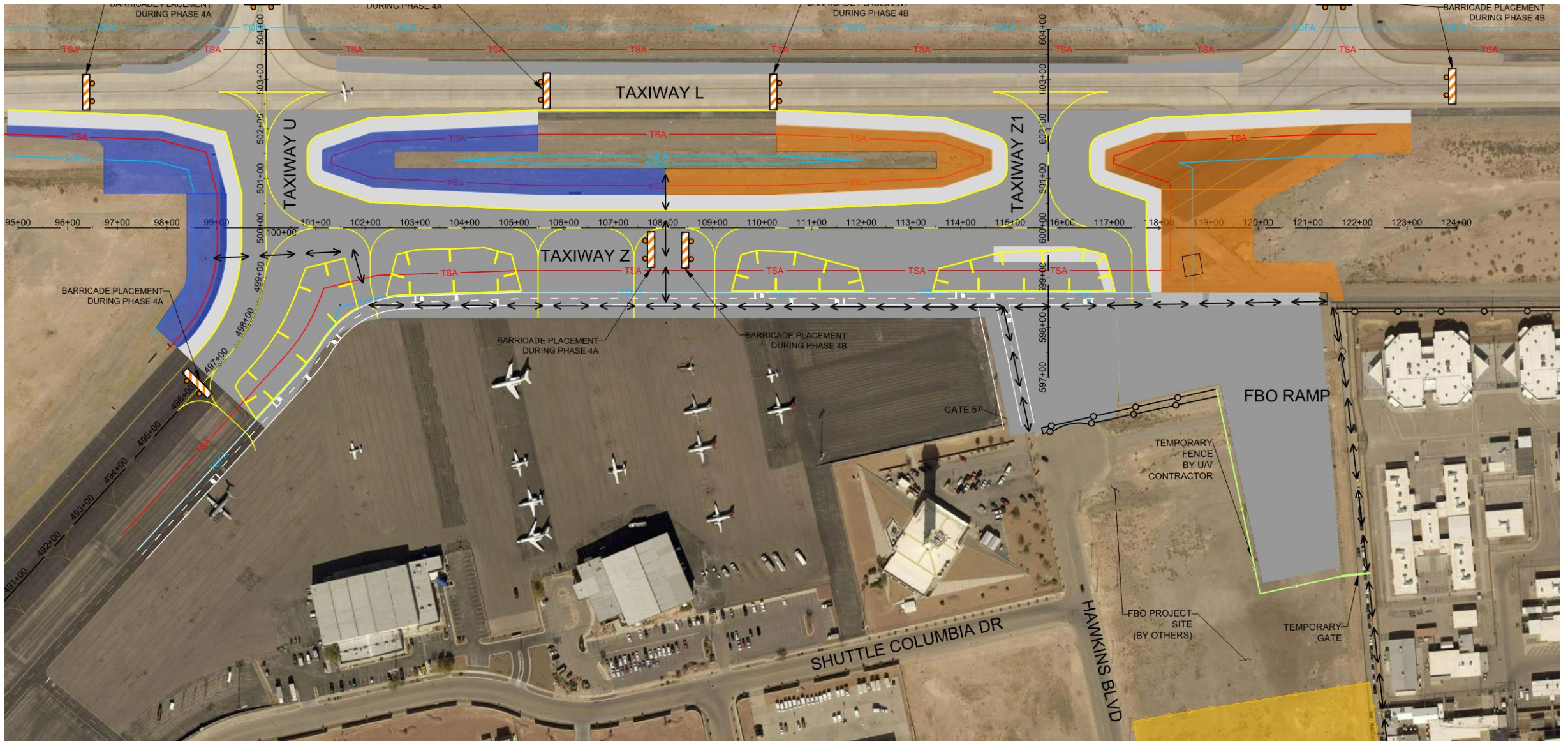
- Reconstruction of portions of TWY U & V to bring these pavement sections and geometry configurations into compliance with current FAA design standards.
