## RESOLUTION TO CENSURE CONDUCT OF REPRESENTATIVE SAM MORGAN

Sam Morgan took the oath, prescribed by the Constitution of the United States, to faithfully execute the Office of City Council Representative; implicit in that oath is the obligation that a member of City Council set an example of high moral standards and conduct themselves in a manner that fosters respect; and

WHEREAS, no person is above the law, and Rep. Sam Morgan remains subject to criminal and civil penalties for his conduct;

**WHEREAS**, Rep. Sam Morgan is entitled to due process of law and is innocent until proven guilty, we as a Council believe the accusation of domestic violence pending against him is a serious charge and that victims should be given trust and solidarity;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council proclaimed the month of October 2019 as National Domestic Violence Awareness month;

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Sam Morgan, City Council Representative, District 4, by his conduct has brought upon himself and fully deserves the censure and condemnation of the citizens of El Paso.
