This Consent to Assignment is executed this day of, 2020, between the
City of El Paso ("City"); George E. Hermann, Trustee for the George E. Hermann Living Trust, a
Florida trust ("Assignor"); and MedVen, LLC ("Assignee").
WHEREAS, on October 18, 2016, the City approved a Tax Abatement Agreement
("Agreement") with Assignor pursuant to Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code; and
WHEREAS, through the Agreement, Assignor agreed to construct a medical office, on the
real property located at 1211 E. Cliff Drive, El Paso, Texas ("Real Property"); and
WHEREAS, upon Assignor meeting minimum investment amounts and obtaining a
Certificate of Occupancy for the Real Property, the City agreed to abate a portion of ad valorem real
taxes from the improvements on the Real Property; and
WHEREAS, the tax abatement period is five years, and with the first year of the tax
abatement beginning on, 20; and
WHEREAS, Assignor is selling the Real Property to Assignee; and
WHEREAS, Assignor has requested that the City consent to the assignment of the
Agreement to Assignee; and
WHEREAS, Assignee agrees to be responsible for all duties and obligations under the
Agreement; and
WHEREAS, the Agreement requires the City's consent to assignment; and
WHEREAS, the City agrees to the assignment of all rights, duties and obligations
encompassed in the Agreement to Assignee.

- 1. The City consents to the assignment of the rights, duties and obligations under the Tax Abatement Agreement approved by Council on October 18, 2016 to Assignee.
