
SOUTH BY SOUTHWEST 2019 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

Overview of 2018 SXSW



As the largest exhibition at SXSW, the Trade Show enhances and complements conference programming with endless unexpected discovery opportunities.

In 2018, there were **735** Trade Show spaces from **27** different countries, with over **75,000** people in attendance. The Trade Show saw exhibitors including **Kuka Robotics**, **Experimental Aircraft Association**, **Institute for Quantum Computing**, **Lockheed Martin**, **Mitsubishi Electric Corp**., and countless others.

Overview of 2018 SXSW



Destination El Paso Team, City of El Paso and County of El Paso came together to showcase El Paso during the 2018 SXSW event in Austin from **March 11**th – **14**th. City of Las Cruces, the University of Texas at El Paso, New Mexico State University and 6 regional start-up companies were also in attendance to showcase the strengths, talent and economic vitality of the region.

In conjunction with SXSW we partnered with **Texas Monthly** to host a reception at the Texas Monthly Headquarters. State officials, state and national meeting planners, UTEP alumni based in Austin and business executives were invited to this event.

-Bring up key regional assets in conversation with individuals from around the world.






