The State of Texas, on behalf of its Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"), has contracted with Abrams-Kiewit Joint Venture to design and construct the Border Highway West Expansion Project, and that upon completion, the Border Highway West Expansion Project will become a State highway; the construction of the Border Highway West Expansion Project will benefit the community; The Border Highway West Expansion Project will incorporate a parcel of land owned by the City of El Paso ("City") into the project, and TxDOT is negotiating with the City for the acquisition of the identified parcel; On Nov. 3, 1998, the City granted a license agreement to Eller Media Company for the display of outdoor advertising signs on the identified City-owned property, and that license agreement has expired; Clear Channel Outdoors, a Delaware Corporation ("Clear Channel"), claims it is a successor in interest to Eller Media Company under the expired license agreement with the City; and TxDOT has requested that the City release any interest it may have in the expired 1998 License Agreement, and TxDOT will negotiate directly with Clear Channel on the relocation of the billboards;
