BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:



Project History

- August 2016 City Council approved Saturday Parking Revenue to fund Sun City Lights
- August 2017 Project approved by City Council \$4.8 million in certificates of obligation for the Sun City Lights Paseo de Luces project to be paid back with Saturday parking meter revenue and other identified funding sources.
- Construction Start: January 2018
- Construction Completion: October 2018
