SUBJECT:

A resolution that the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages by Ardivino's Wine Gourmet & Gifts, INC, in the closed portions of City rights-of-way on Cincinnati Avenue and Baltimore Avenue, between Stanton Street and Mesa Street, to include the adjacent alleys from 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 17, 2015 through 2:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 18, 2015 is a permissible activity in conjunction with Hard Liquors, LLC's Bourbon Street on Cincinnati Street 2015 upon issuance of the required permits from the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the City of El Paso (CSEV15-00006) District 1.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

EVENT NAME: Bourbon Street on Cincinnati Street 2015

PERMIT CASE NUMBER: CSEV15-00006

EVENT DATE/HOURS: February 17, 2015, 4:00 p.m. – February, 18, 2015, 2:00 a.m.

LOCATION: Cincinnati Avenue and Baltimore Avenue, between Stanton Street and Mesa Street, to include the adjacent alleys.

APPLICANT: Hard Liquors, LLC

TABC PERMITTEE: Ardivino's Wine Gourmet & Gifts, INC

As per Section 15.08.120 (O) of the El Paso Municipal Code, the Special Privilege Permit (CSEV15-00006) event application was submitted to Planning & Inspections. Council must approve the sale and service of alcohol in the right-of-way in order for the applicant to proceed with the event as described in their application and obtain proper licensing from the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC). The Applicant assumes full responsibility for TABC Permittee and has provided event insurance in accordance with Section 15.08.120 (G).

The following conditions to be placed and attached to the permit upon issuance:

1. All outdoor stages will have speakers facing Mesa.
2. Trash to be removed from the closed portions of City right-of-way and a four block radius, prior to 02/18/2015, 8AM.
3. Applicant must promote the use of the Glory Road Transit Terminal for patrons in lieu of parking within the residential neighborhood adjacent to the events.
4. Must comply with all Fire and PD requirements.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

In 2013, after receiving public input, special provisions to address noise restrictions and cleaning plans were requested. The issues were address through the aforementioned conditions. The conditions were placed on the permit by staff in 2013 and 2014.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

WHEREAS, Hard Liquors, LLC (hereinafter referred to as “Grantee”) is producing Bourbon Street on Cincinnati Street 2015 to be open to the public from 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 17, 2015 through 2:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 18, 2015 (hereinafter referred to as “Event”); and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has submitted an application for a Special Privilege Permit pursuant to Title 15.08.120 (D) of the El Paso Municipal Code, for the use and closure of portions of City rights-of-way on Cincinnati Avenue and Baltimore Avenue, between Stanton Street and Mesa Street, to include the adjacent alleys in conjunction with the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has indicated their intent to authorize Ardovino’s Wine Gourmet & Gifts, INC, (hereinafter referred as “TABC Permittee”) to provide for the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages within the identified closed portions of City rights-of-way during the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC) requires that the City Council for the City of El Paso approve, as a permissible activity, the sale and service of alcoholic beverages within City rights-of-way, prior to issuance of such permit; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee assumes full responsibility for the TABC Permittee, including verification that the Permittee has obtained a permit for the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages from the TABC prior to the Event.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the temporary sale and service of alcoholic beverages by Ardovino’s Wine Gourmet & Gifts, INC, in the closed portions of City rights-of-way on Cincinnati Avenue and Baltimore Avenue, between Stanton Street and Mesa Street, to include the adjacent alleys from 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, February 17, 2015 through 2:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 18, 2015 is a permissible activity in conjunction with Hard Liquors, LLC’s Bourbon Street on Cincinnati Street 2015 upon issuance of the required permits from the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the City of El Paso.

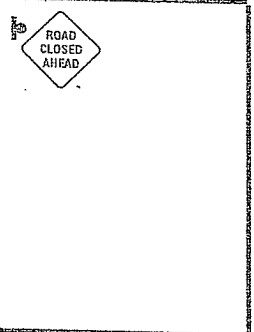
