2018 OVERVIEW

- Destination El Paso, City of El Paso and County of El Paso came together to showcase El Paso from March 11th – 14th.
- City of Las Cruces, the University of Texas at El Paso, New Mexico State University and 6 regional start-up companies were also in attendance.
- Partnered with Texas Monthly to host a reception at the Texas Monthly Headquarters.
- State officials, state and national meeting planners, UTEP alumni based in Austin and business executives were invited to attend.
