**WHEREAS**, Company E, 2nd Battalion, 141st Infantry Regiment of the 36th Division of the Texas National Guard was federalized and activated into the U.S. 5th Army and saw action in Northern Africa, Italy, Southern France, and Germany in World War II; and

**WHEREAS**, the majority of the men of Company E attended or graduated from Bowie High School and were from El Paso; and

**WHEREAS**, many of these brave men of Company E paid the ultimate sacrifice and gave their lives to fight for their country; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires that a segment of State Loop 375 be designated in honor of Company E.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**



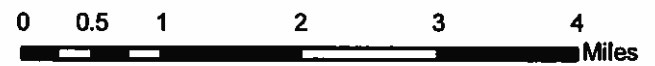
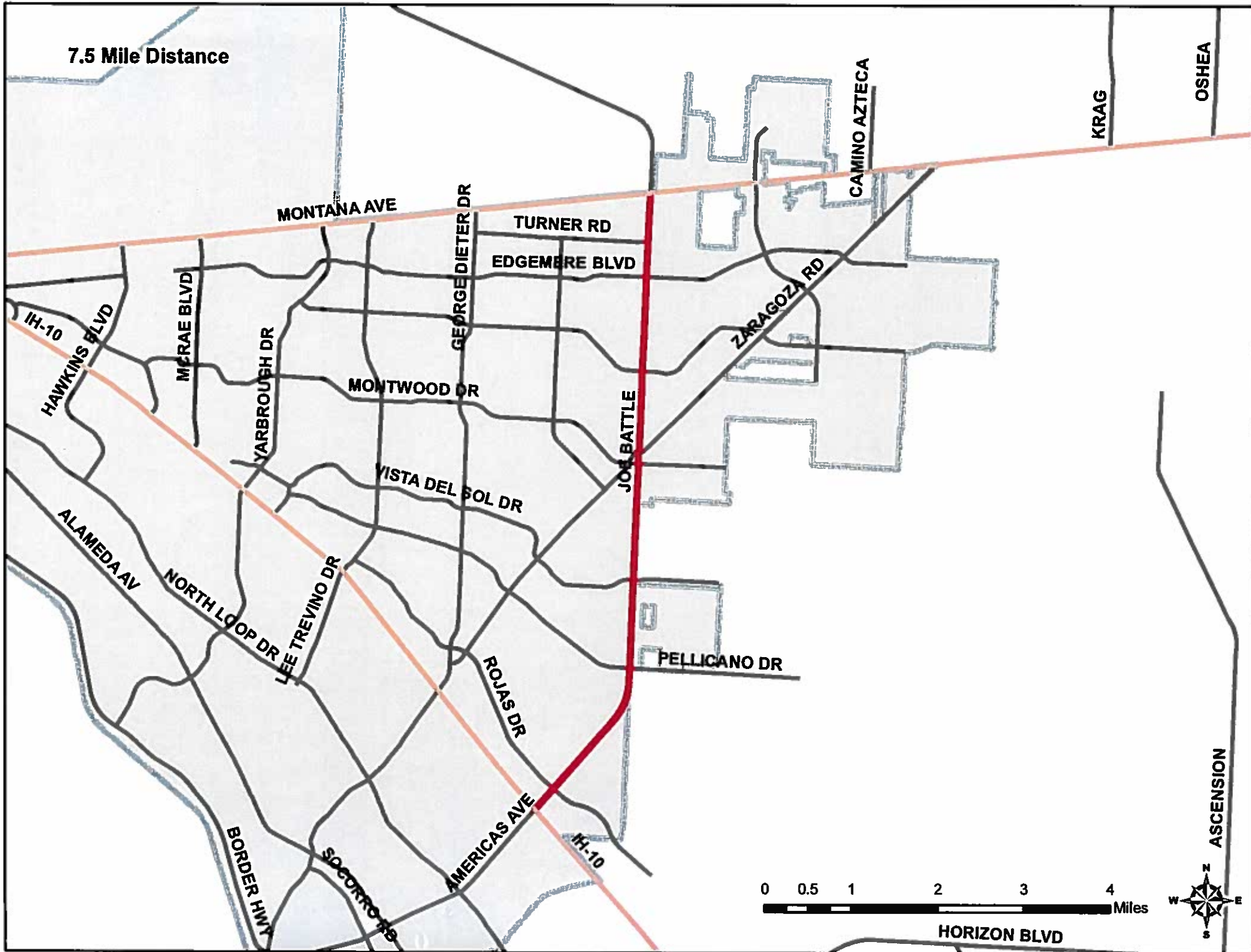
