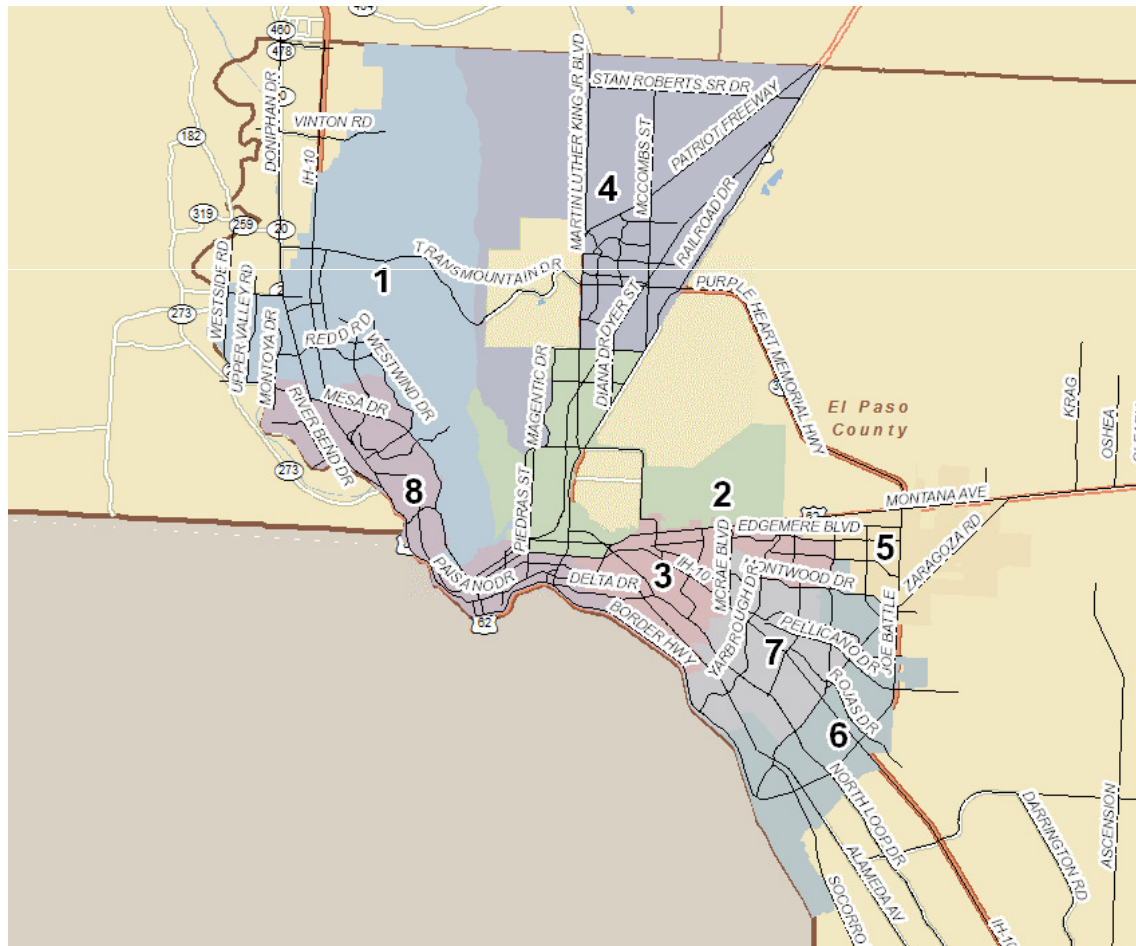

Plan Composition – Scope of Work

- **Great Streets Policy**
 - Overall Policy Statement
 - Goals & Objectives

- **Design Standards**
 - General Design Standards
 - New Cross-Sections/Guidelines

- **Implementation Plan**
 - Identification of which roadways/corridors – funded, designed, or in progress – meet policy and design standards

- **Thoroughfare Plan**
 - Review and reclassification of some roadways on MTP
 - Map to identify before/after roadway reclassifications
