## 3.3 RESOLUTION

That the City Manager or designee is authorized to disburse the City's required match of \$25,967 to the Texas Events Trust Fund so that the City may qualify for reimbursement for all statutorily allowed City expenditures pursuant to Texas state law in conjunction with the 2014 Conference USA Basketball Tournament and that, the City Manager is authorized to enter into an Agreement with the County of El Paso, the University of Texas at El Paso and the El Paso Sports Commission to support the Event pursuant to which the City will cover 50% of a revenue shortfall of more than \$50,000.00, with the City's portion not to exceed \$225,000.00; and that, the City Manager is authorized to sign the Event Support Contract between the City and Conference USA whereby the City pays to CUSA: 1) a site fee in the amount of \$100,000.00; 2) the Event net revenue shortfall payment described in the immediately preceding paragraph in a maximum amount of \$225,000, and, 3) a maximum amount of \$10,000 to cover other miscellaneous Event-related expenses; and to make appropriate budget transfers to effectuate these payments. **All Districts** Destination El Paso, Bryan Crowe, (915) 534-0667
