SUBJECT:

That the City Manager be authorized to sign an Interlocal Agreement between the City of El Paso ("The City") and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TXDOT") for the El Paso Police Department (EPPD) to provide uniformed officers and equipment necessary for law enforcement, general surveillance, and traffic control at and around sites for which TXDOT is providing maintenance, repair, construction and other services to State maintained roads and highways. Such services are to promote safety of construction zone workers and the traveling public. In lieu, TXDOT will pay up to \$107,241.60 for this service on a reimbursement basis for actual salary and vehicle costs for a twenty-four month period beginning upon the execution of the agreement by both parties and ending two years from that date.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City Manager be authorized to sign an Interlocal Agreement between the City of El Paso ("The City") and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TXDOT") for the El Paso Police Department (EPPD) to provide uniformed officers and equipment necessary for law enforcement, general surveillance, and traffic control at and around sites for which TXDOT is providing maintenance, repair, construction and other services to State maintained roads and highways. Such services are to promote safety of construction zone workers and the traveling public. In lieu, TXDOT will pay up to \$110,414.64 for this service on a reimbursement basis for actual salary and vehicle costs for a twenty-four month period beginning upon the execution of the agreement by both parties and ending two years from that date.
