SUBJECT:

An Ordinance providing or a waiver of certain fees for special event permits as required in Title 5, Title 9, Title 12. Title 13, and Title 15 of the El Paso City Code.

An Ordinance amending Title 5 (Business License and Permit Regulations), Chapter 5.03 (Charitable Solicitations), Chapter 5.15 (Vendors and Solicitors) of the El Paso City Code, to repeal Charitable Solicitation permits and to exempt certain vendors from the license requirement. The penalties are provided in Chapter 5.01.100 of the El Paso City Code.

An Ordinance Amending Title 9 (Health and Safety), Chapter 9.40 (Noise), Chapter 9.52 (Fire Prevention Code) of the El Paso City Code, to exempt special events permits from the Noise Ordinance. The penalties are provide in Chapter 9.40.140 of the El Paso City Code.

An Ordinance Amending Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.56 (Parking Meters), of the El Paso City Code, to exempt parking meter fees for special event permits. The penalties are provided in Chapter 12.84.010 of the El Paso City Code.

An Ordinance Amending Title 13 (Streets, Sidewalks, and Public Spaces), Chapter 13.28 (Sound Amplifying Devices) and Chapter 13.32 (Temporary Events) of the El Paso City Code to exempt special event permits from the sound amplification permit and to amend the payment and cancellation policy for a special event permit. The penalties are provided in Chapter 13.32.090 of the El Paso City Code.

An Ordinance Amending Title 15 Title 15 (Public Services), Chapter 15.08 (Street Rentals) of the El Paso City Code, to delete certain additional costs and fees associated with special event permits. The penalty is provided in Chapter 15.08.070 of the El Paso City Code.

A Resolution amending Schedule C for the City of El Paso FY2013 Budget Resolution, to delete certain established fees related to the special privilege temporary use fees and for charitable solicitation as part of the streamlining of the special event process. Mis 1/24

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

During a Special City Council Meeting/Work Session held on October 18, 2012, the Council supported a proposal to reform the process for special events held in the public right-of-way, either downtown or elsewhere. Some changes to various codes are necessary in order to streamline and reduce the process time necessary to approve permits for these events.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.56 (PARKING METERS), OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, TO EXEMPT PARKING METER FEES FOR SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS, THE PENALTIES ARE PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 12.84.010 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

SECTION 1. That Title 12 Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 12.56 Parking Meters, Section 12.56.020, Subsection F of the El Paso City Code be amended as follows:

F. The International Bridges Director, may designate areas in which the parking meter fee shall apply (1) at all times or (2) specific days and/or hours of the day, provided that the parking meter fee shall not apply during the hours when the fee is specifically exempted for special downtown events or events permitted with a Special Event Permit. In all other areas, the parking meter fee is required between the hours of eight a.m. and six p.m. of every day except on officially designated city holidays, and hours when the parking meter fee is specifically exempted for special downtown events or events permitted with a Special Event Permit, and except on Saturday (from September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013) and Sunday, but said Saturday exception shall not include those meters located on Alberta Street.
