Neighborhood Improvement Program

Program Purpose:

- NIP is a competitive program for recognized neighborhood associations to apply for small-scale physical improvement projects that improve the quality of life in a neighborhood

City Council Awarded NIP Rounds:

- *Round 1* – Approved 4/17/07
- *Round 2* – Approved 4/15/08
- *Round 3* – Approved 3/16/10
- *Round 3.5* – Approved 12/21/10



Neighborhood Improvement Program

Projects must meet the following:

- Requested by a recognized neighborhood association
- Permanent physical improvement on city-owned property that benefits the community
- Small-scale project (funding cap at approx. \$50,000)
- Targets neighborhoods at least 10 years old or older
- Applicants must demonstrate neighborhood support

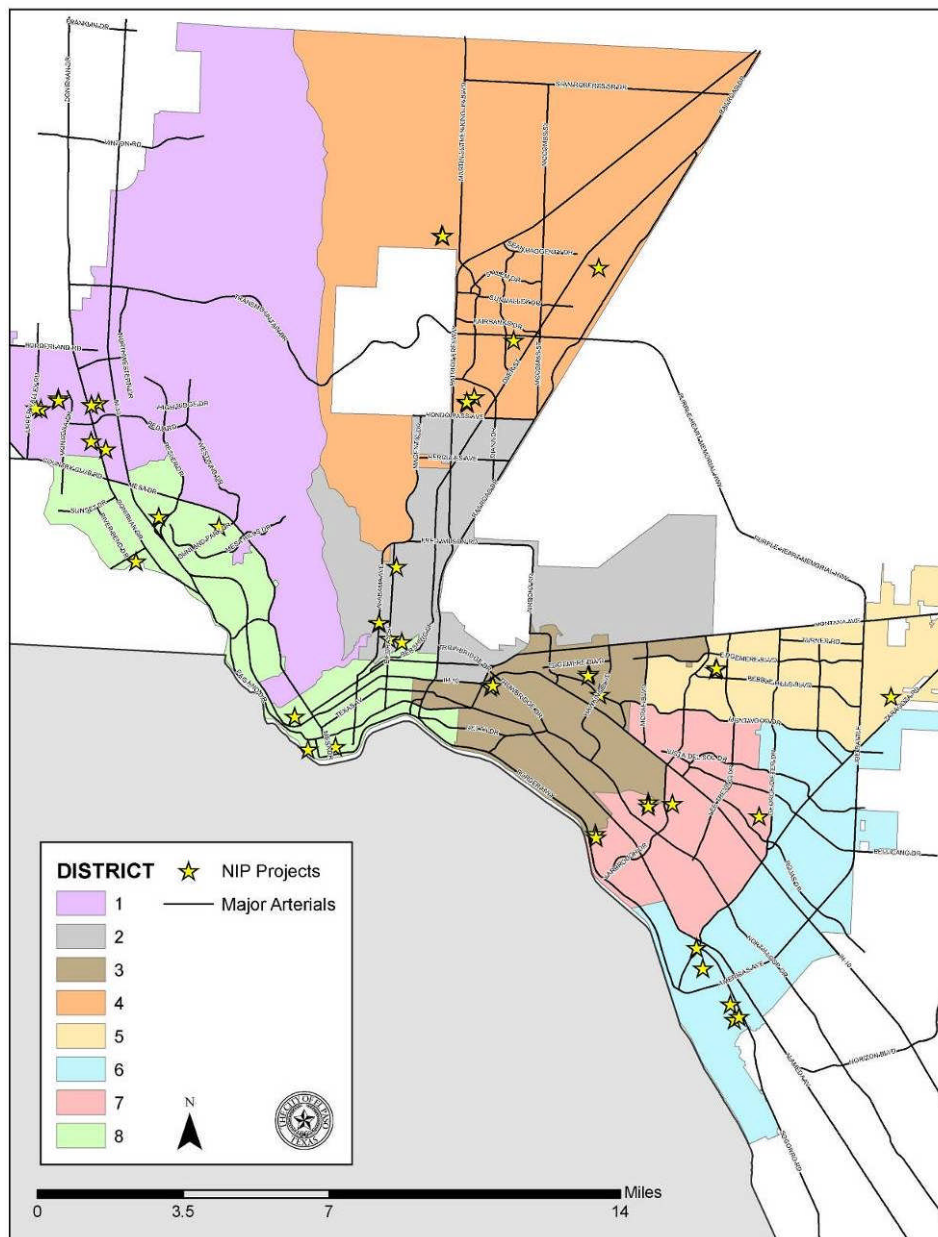
