

# **Construction Update**

# Coordination with FTA/TxDOT State Safety Oversight Agency

- SSOA performed their site visit Feb 27 Mar 1 to conduct a System Readiness Review and an initial inspection of the streetcar system
  - SSOA will evaluate the visit and interviews, and provide recommendations to enter pre-revenue service for safety certification
  - Draft Report on System Readiness by SSOA Contractors due Apr 15<sup>th</sup>
- Sun Metro is preparing Standard Operating Procedures for review by the SSOA
- Sun Metro sent Streetcar testing plan to SSOA as requested
- SSOA safety certification is expected Aug/Sep 2018, which is necessary to start revenue service



# **CRRMA and COEP**Transition Timelines

- CRRMA is responsible for Streetcar system construction
- Hand-off to the COEP will be incremental as infrastructure and PCC cars are certified operational
  - Maintenance facility hand-off to COEP/Sun Metro the week of Apr 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Electrical and rail Infrastructure should be completed for hand-off early 2018
  - 1st PCC car arrived Mar 19 and should be certified for hand-off in late Apr
  - PCC cars 2-6 will arrive one-by-one, between Apr and Oct 2018
  - Revenue service projected to start in Nov 2018



## Other Streetcar Activities

- Interviews for 3 mechanic technicians should take place the week of Apr 2
- Streetcar testing before Burn-in include:
  - Brake and acceleration
  - Clearance and comfort



## **Arrival of Streetcars**



### **PCC Car Timelines**

- 1st PCC car arrived Mar 19 and be certified for hand-off to COEP/Sun Metro in late Apr
  - Brookville has started to ship capital spares last week
  - The PCC car must pass 200 miles of perfect continuous operations in El Paso to be accepted
- PCC cars 2-6 will arrive one-by-one, between Apr and Oct 2018
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> PCC car, #1512, is scheduled to leave Brookville the week of Apr 23rd
  - Must pass 50 miles of perfect continuous operations to be accepted
