

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code Chapter 311 grants home-rule municipalities exclusive control over and under the public highways, streets, and alleys of the municipality, including the assigning of street names to highways within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the process for the naming of a state highway within a municipality is set forth in the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT's) Signs and Markings Manual, Chapter 7, Section 18; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT's Signs and Markings Manual requires the municipality enact a resolution or ordinance naming the highway and forward the resolution or ordinance to the TxDOT district office for review of the name; and

WHEREAS, Representative Ann Lilly submitted an application to City Council recommending that Loop 375 Transmountain West Hike and Bike Trail on the north side, from Resler to Paseo del Norte, be named the Elizabeth F. Hernandez Memorial Hike and Bike Trail; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to accept the recommendation that Loop 375 Transmountain West Hike and Bike Trail on the north side, from Resler to Paseo del Norte, be named the Elizabeth F. Hernandez Memorial Hike and Bike Trail.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City Council accept the recommendation of Representative Ann Lilly to name Loop 375 Transmountain West Hike and Bike Trail, on the north side, from Resler to Paseo del Norte, the Elizabeth F. Hernandez Memorial Hike and Bike Trail and authorize the City Manager to forward this resolution to the Texas Department of Transportation for approval of the name and execute any necessary documents to effectuate the adoption of the name and make any budget transfers necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
