AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 012985 WHICH VACATED, FOR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, A PORTION OF SAN FRANCISCO AVENUE AND EL PASO STREET ABUTTING PORTIONS OF BLOCK 16, MILLS ADDITION, AND BLOCK 17, HERALD ADDITION, CITY OF EL PASO, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS, TO REOPEN A PORTION OF SAN FRANCISCO AVENUE TO ALLOW VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1996, the City Council of the City of El Paso approved the vacation of a portion of San Francisco Avenue abutting Block 17, Herald Addition, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas, and closed to public vehicular use a portion of San Francisco Avenue and El Paso Street abutting portions of Block 16, Mills Addition, and Block 17, Herald Addition, City of El Paso, El Paso County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the portions closed to public vehicular use were intended to be used in connection with the Arts Festival Plaza as an environment from which pedestrians can enjoy various cultural events, subject to the entire length and width of the right-of-way being retained as a utility easement and the area readily accessible to utility companies for maintenance, repair and replacement of their facilities; and,

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of City Council to reopen a portion of San Francisco Avenue for public vehicular use in order to provide ease of vehicular movement in downtown El Paso; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing regarding the amending of the Ordinance, the City Plan Commission recommended that a portion of San Francisco Avenue abutting portions of Block 16, Mills Addition, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas be reopened to public vehicular use; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that the portion of San Francisco Avenue should be reopened to public vehicular use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 012985 is hereby amended to add the following: That effective upon approval of this Ordinance the portion of San Francisco Avenue abutting portions of Block 16, Mills Addition, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas and which is more fully described in the attached metes and bounds description, identified as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference be and is hereby reopened for public vehicular use.

Section 2: That the remainder of Ordinance No. 012985 remains in full force and effect.



AN ORDINANCE VACATING PORTIONS OF SAN FRANCISCO AVENUE AND EL PASO STREET ABUTTING PORTIONS OF BLOCK 16, MILLS ADDITION, AND BLOCK 17, HERALD ADDITION, CITY OF EL PASO, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS.


