An ordinance amending Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.200 (Schedule XVII – Restrictions On Parking In Residential Districts), of the El Paso City Code, to create a new zone for the Sunset Heights Neighborhood, the penalty being as provided in Section 12.84.010 and Chapter 12.85 of the El Paso City Code.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Parking demands in the Sunset Heights Neighborhood adjacent to the ballpark have changed significantly. Area residents may be denied parking near their homes, due to events in downtown area. This ordinance will restrict parking close to housing to residents that purchase an annual permit.



ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.200 (SCHEDULE XVII – RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS), OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, TO CREATE A NEW ZONE FOR THE SUNSET HEIGHTS NEIGHBORHOOD, THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 AND CHAPTER 12.85 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.200 (Schedule XVII – Restrictions on parking in residential districts), of the El Paso City Code, is hereby amended to add a new zone to read as follows:

Zone U: No parking, 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Everyday

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of West Yandell Drive with the southeast curblane of Fewel Street;

Thence southwest along the northeast curblane of Fewel Street to its intersection with the northeast curblane of Mundy Drive;

Thence northwest along the northeast curblane of Mundy Drive to its intersection with the west curblane of Lawton Drive;

Thence south along the west curblane of Lawton Drive to its intersection with the south curblane of Missouri Avenue;

Thence west along the south curblane of Missouri Avenue to its intersection with the east curblane of Porfirio Diaz Street; and

Thence south along the east curblane of Porfirio Diaz Street to its intersection with the northeast curblane of Main Street;

Thence east along the north curblane of Main Street/Interstate Highway 10 to its intersection with the northeast curblane of Yandell Drive;

Thence northwest along the northeast curblane of Yandell Drive to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Except as expressly herein amended, that Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.





Thence west along the south curblane of Missouri Avenue to its intersection with the east curblane of Porfirio Diaz Street; and

Thence south along the east curblane of Porfirio Diaz Street to its intersection with the northeast curblane of Main Street;
