**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF EL PASO BIKE PLAN TO DELETE RESLER CANYON CONNECTION FROM THE CITY OF EL PASO BIKE PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, on August 9, 2016, the City of El Paso adopted the El Paso Bike Plan under Ordinance number 018557; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bicycle Advisory Committee has recommended the deletion of the Resler Canyon Connection from the El Paso Bike Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment helps to enhance and sustain El Paso's infrastructure network.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

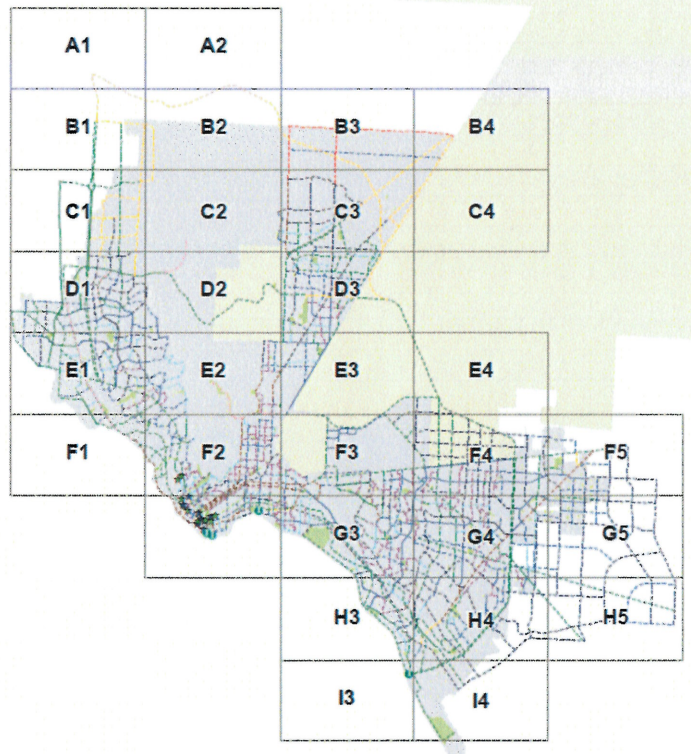
