ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF EL PASO BIKE PLAN TO DELETE RESLER CANYON CONNECTION FROM THE CITY OF EL PASO BIKE PLAN.
WHEREAS , on August 9, 2016, the City of El Paso adopted the El Paso Bike Plan under Ordinance number 018557; and
WHEREAS , the Bicycle Advisory Committee has recommended the deletion of the Resler Canyon Connection from the El Paso Bike Plan; and


