Background

- Existing bus stops are non ADA compliant
- Provide only one landing area for front door of bus





Bus Stop Enhancements Year 4

Scope of Work

- Remove existing narrow sidewalk and parkway material
- Install new concrete pavement, 40 foot long by width of parkway
- Install base for bus stop sign
- New construction compliant with ADA standards

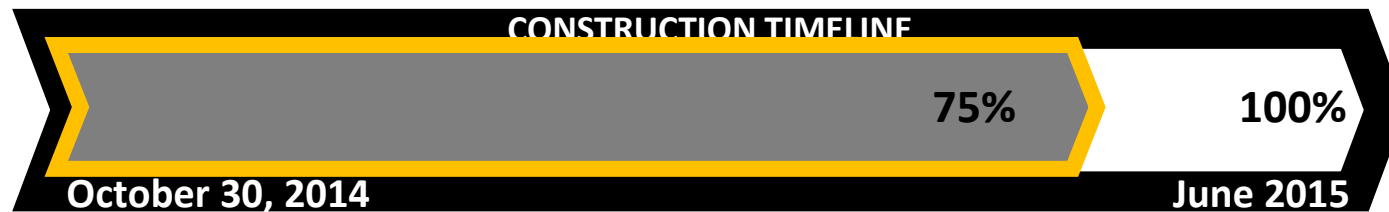
