LED DISPLAY

Easy to read display indicates

1. Storage space
2. Length of recorded event
3. Recording is in progress
4. Battery display
5. Number of recordings requiring upload





BWC

The Vista Wi-Fi gathers audio and visual evidence.

The Microphone sensor records CD quality audio and uses noise filtration software to enhance voices.

The camera turret adjusts up 20 degrees and downward 20 degree for different viewing angles



Recordings start and stop through the on off button located in the front of the camera

The Vista Camera system and the in car MVR are both designed by WatchGuard

When they are within a 75 ft radius all linked devices within the bubble will automatically synchronize and be available to download as one event

Storage and retention

BWC videos are stored on a city server.

Retention periods follow the state mandated retention policy for videos that have a criminal classification

Unclassified videos follow the city retention policy of 90 days
(The department retention policy is at 180 days)



REQUIRED RETENTION PERIODS

Admin/Default	180 days (6 months)
Traffic Accident	180 days (6 months)
Incident	180 days (6 months)
Traffic Stop	180 days (6 months)
Misdemeanor Offense Report	730 days (2 years)
DWI	3650 days (10 years)
Felony Offense Report	3650 days (10 years)
Capital or 1 st Degree Felony	18250 days (50 years)
