Project Details

- **Local Project Funding Agreement (LPAFA) was approved on May 1, 2018.**
- **Project will provide:**
 - **Improved pedestrian connectivity along the Montana RTS Corridor**
 - **Encourage economic activity by providing improved pedestrian amenities.**

Existing Conditions



Scope of Work

- The project includes the design and construction of ADA and landscape improvements to Montana Avenue from Raynor Street to Chelsea Street as follows:
 - Traffic signal upgrades (Raynor, Huckleberry, Chelsea, and Copia) to include Accessible Pedestrian Signal (APS) systems
 - Complete demolition of parkway areas (as needed to provide ADA access)
 - ADA accessible sidewalk reconstruction
 - Curb and gutter
 - Removal and installation of street signage and striping at intersections
 - ADA curb ramps
 - Driveway reconstruction to provide ADA compliant driveways
 - Asphalt patching next to gutter
 - Landscaping and irrigation where right of way constraints allow



Procurement Summary

- Request for Qualification advertised for 14 days
 - 6 firms submitted bids
- Recommended Actions
 - To award Huitt Zollars, Inc. as the most qualified bidder in the amount of \$287,180
