

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.010 (SCHEDULE I – ONE-WAY STREETS), OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, TO DELETE SAN ANTONIO AVENUE FROM EL PASO STREET TO FLORENCE STREET, THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 AND CHAPTER 12.85 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.010 (Schedule I – One-way streets), of the El Paso City Code, is amended to delete line 22 which reads as follows:

12.88.010 Schedule I – One-way streets.

22. Eastbound from El Paso Street to Florence Street; provided, streetcars may operate in either direction on San Antonio Avenue so far as necessary to make switching movement in connection with the turn of the existing tracks at the intersection of San Antonio Avenue and Stanton Street.

Section 2. Except as herein amended, Title 12, Chapter 12.88, of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.
