SUBJECT: Review of Tax Overpayment Refunds that Exceed Three Years

The Internal Audit Office conducted a review of the Tax Overpayment Refunds that exceed a three-year period. This engagement was accepted based on the engagement's potential to improve management of risks, add value, and/or improve the organization's operations (IIA 2010.C1). The work performed does not constitute an audit conducted in accordance with <u>Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards</u> (GAS 2.12). The observations and conclusions that are reported in this memorandum do not require Management responses.

The following Tax Overpayment Refund that exceeded a three-year period was reviewed:

LOUIS SAIZ JR N463-999-0080-1700 \$ 2,844.58

The Internal Audit Office reviewed the refund application, copies of cancelled checks or proof of payments. Attached is a list of days from the date the completed application was received by the Tax Office and sent to the Internal Audit Office for review. The Tax Office took 3 days to process the application received and send for review.

Based on our review, the Tax Overpayment Refund that exceeded a three-year period was determined to be appropriate to send to City Council for approval pursuant to Section 31.11 (c-1) of the Texas Tax Code.
