Request that the Engineering and Construction Management Department be authorized to issue a purchase order to Advanced Security Contractors, Inc., a contractor under the Education Service Center Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative, Contract #09-6356, for an access system for gates and doors to be installed at the Municipal Vehicle Storage Facility. Participation by the City of El Paso in the Education Service Center Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative was approved by City Council March 4, 2008.

**BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:**

The access control system doors and gates are necessary to facilitate access for employees and contractors at the Municipal Vehicle Storage Facility. Ten access control doors will be installed in the building and four access control gates will be installed throughout the impound lot. The access control gates will ease ingress and egress from the impound lot for the towing vehicles.

**PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:**

City Council approved participation by the City of El Paso in the Education Service Center Region 19 Purchasing Cooperative March 4, 2008. City Council approved the use of General Fund Reserves for the Municipal Vehicle Storage Facility April 19, 2011.




Dear Jennifer,

Thank you for allowing *Advanced Security Contractors, Inc.* to provide a proposal for the installation of a Hirsch access control system for the new Impound Facility located at 11615 Railroad Dr. ASC will install ten access control doors in the facility as shown as blue circles in the below drawing. ASC will also install four gates with hydraulic operators outside located at points 11, 12, 13 & 14 shown in blue. These gates will have wireless receivers inside that a pushbutton remote will open. Gate #14 will have a fire Knox box installed. The Knox box is the responsibility of the City, although ASC will install it. Each gate will have safety loops. ASC will also install a request to exit pushbutton at the receptionist office to open the lobby door as shown in yellow below.

The city is responsibility for providing AC power at the panels and at each gate. Conduits to each door and to each gate for data to the IT room are also the responsibility of the City of El Paso. ASC will provide the gates, operators and loops. The City is responsible for providing the concrete pad for the operators and for the mounting of the poles. ASC will work with the GC that the city hires to install in the pads and poles where ASC needs them.

### DOOR SCHEDULE:

1. Front Doors -- Double magnetic locks with a request to exit motion detector installed.
2. Vault Door -- Reader outside with a door strike
3. Cashiers Door -- Reader outside with a door strike
4. Lobby Corridor Door -- Reader outside with a door strike. The receptionist will be able to control this door via a pushbutton as shown in yellow below.
5. Security Office -- Reader outside with a door strike
6. IT room -- Reader outside with a door strike
7. Corridor to Inspection Bay -- Reader in the corridor with a door strike



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8. Back door – Reader on the outside with a door strike
9. Processing Bay - Reader on the outside with a door strike
10. Inspection Bay – Reader on the outside with a door strike
11. Gate 11 – Remote receiver to trigger opening
12. Gate 12 – Remote receiver to trigger opening
13. Gate 13 – Remote receiver to trigger opening
14. Gate 14 – Remote receiver to trigger opening and a fire Knox box for emergency opening.




