PROCESS:

The patented URETEK Deep Injection Process for soil stabilization is accomplished by injecting the URETEK 486 polymer through tubes inserted into holes drilled through the pavement down into the soils approximately 3' below the surface, while monitoring for movement at the surface of the pavement. The material flows into the soils, quickly expands, thereby stabilizing the soils to stiffen the sub-base and base material to sufficient strength to properly support the load. Injection then continues from depth as needed to lift the pavement into place.

Warranty

URETEK will provide a two-year bumper-to-bumper warranty against material shrinkage. In the unlikely event that movement of more than ¼" in the injected areas occurs, URETEK will return to inject the affected area to provide further stabilization at no additional cost.
