That the City Manager be authorized to execute a Resolution nominating Helen of Troy L.P. as an Enterprise Project to the Office of the Governor of Economic Development and Tourism through the Economic Development Bank as an Enterprise Zone Project. BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Helen of Troy L.P. is headquartered in El Paso, Texas where it began its operations in 1968. The applicant offers an array of products for customers to help meet their household, health and beauty needs through a strong portfolio of well-recognized and widely trusted brands.

The applicant is requesting that the City of El Paso nominate their company for an Enterprise Zone Project designation. The applicant is investing \$8 million in their distribution facility in El Paso, Texas which employs 417 full-time employees. The \$8 Million investment that will be done over the next five years is expected to improve the company's technological and operational activities. Helen of Troy L.P. meets the criteria for tax relief and other incentives adopted by the City, as its business is located in an Enterprise Zone, will retain or create jobs, and maintain economic activity and stability. Furthermore, nominating Helen of Troy for a Texas Enterprise Zone Designation will have no impact on El Paso's General Fund.

Yes—On May 26, 2009, City Council adopted an ordinance that allows the City to participate in the Enterprise Zone Program.

A RESOLUTION NOMINATING HELEN OF TROY L.P. AS A TEXAS STATE ENTERPRISE ZONE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso ('City") passed Ordinance No. 017116 on May 26, 2009, electing for the City to participate in the Texas Enterprise Zone Program; and

WHEREAS, the local incentives offered under this Resolution are the same on this date as were outlined in Ordinance No. 017116; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 2303, Subchapter F of the Texas Enterprise Zone Act, Texas Government Code ("Act"), Helen of Troy L.P., has applied to the City for designation as an enterprise zone project; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor Economic Development and Tourism ("EDC") through the Economic Development Bank ("Bank") will consider Helen of Troy L.P., as an enterprise zone project pursuant to a nomination and an application made by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to pursue the creation of the proper economic and social environment in order to induce the investment of private resources in productive business enterprises located in the city and to provide employment to residents of enterprise zones and to other economically disadvantaged individuals; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that Helen of Troy L.P., meets the criteria for designation as an enterprise project under Chapter 2303, Subchapter F of the Act on the following grounds:

- 1. Helen of Troy L.P. is a "qualified business" under Section 2303.402 of the Act since it will be engaged in the active conduct of a trade or business at a qualified business site located inside an enterprise zone and at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the business' new employees will be residents of an enterprise zone or economically disadvantaged individuals; and
- 2. There has been and will continue to be a high level of cooperation between public, private, and neighborhood entities within the area; and
- 3. The designation of Helen of Troy L.P. as an enterprise project will contribute significantly to the achievement of the plans of the City for development and revitalization of the area.

WHEREAS, the City finds that Helen of Troy L.P. meets the criteria for tax relief and other incentives adopted by the City and agrees to nominate Helen of Troy L.P. for enterprise zone project status on the grounds that it will be located at the qualified business site, will create a higher level of employment, economic activity and stability; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that it is in the best interest of the City to nominate Helen of Troy L.P. as an enterprise project pursuant to the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

- 1. That Helen of Troy L.P., to be known as the Helen of Troy Capital Investment Project, is a "qualified business" as defined in Section 2303.402 of the Act, and meets the criteria for designation as an enterprise project, as set forth in Section 2303, Subchapter F of the Act;
- 2. That the enterprise zone project shall take effect on the date of designation of the enterprise project by the agency and terminate five years after date of designation; and
- 3. That the City Manager or her designee be authorized to sign any and all documents required by EDC to complete the nomination process.
