WHEREAS, taxpayer, Bank of America ("Taxpayer") has applied for a refund with the tax assessor for their 2012 property taxes that were overpaid on December 18, 2012 in the amount of \$3,451.77 for all taxing entities; and

WHEREAS, City Council may extend the deadline for the Taxpayer's application for the overpayment of the 2012 taxes for a period not to exceed two years on a showing of good cause by the taxpayer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **EL PASO:**
