Approve an ordinance amending Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.200 (Schedule XVII – Restrictions on Parking in Residential Districts) of the El Paso City Code to add the area bounded by Resler Drive, Escondido Drive, Westwind Drive, Northwind Drive and Cloudview Drive, the penalty being as provided in section 12.84.010 and Chapter 12.85 of the El Paso City Code.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The request for parking restrictions near Coronado High School was initiated by residents due to students parking on residential streets during school hours, blocking residents' driveways and leaving behind trash. The quality of life of these residents is being negatively impacted by a lack of available parking on school days between 7:00am and 4:00pm, inability to access their own driveways, and a visually unattractive neighborhood. Restricting parking on school days will make parking more available to residents, will enhance their quality of life and improve the visual impression of the community.




