- Asphalt resurfacing of Raynor Street from Paisano to San Antonio
- Replaced non-ADA compliant and damaged sidewalk and ramps
- Replace damaged curb and gutter
- New parkway landscaping and irrigation
- Installed forty seven 4-inch caliper trees
- Installed median island as traffic calming measures at the intersection of Raynor Street and Finley
