## Scope of Work

- **Asphalt resurfacing of Raynor Street from Paisano to San Antonio**
- **Replaced non-ADA compliant and damaged sidewalk and ramps**
- **Replace damaged curb and gutter**
- **New parkway landscaping and irrigation**
- **Installed forty seven 4-inch caliper trees**
- **Installed median island as traffic calming measures at the intersection of Raynor Street and Finley**

- **Installed Franklin Red Gravel mulch on the parkway**



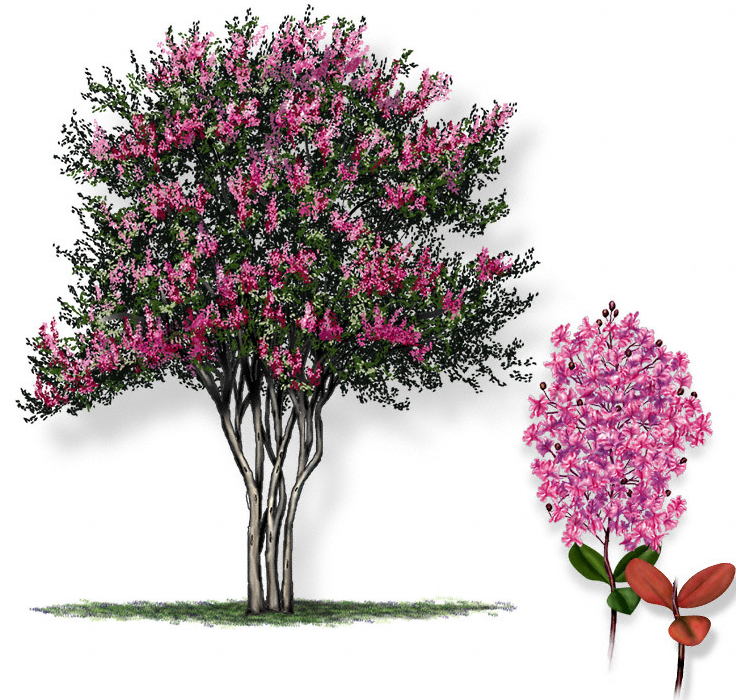
