Public Safety Radio System Overview

- Public Safety Radio System - PD, Fire, Animal Control, Sun Metro, Airport, & Health
- Reconfiguration of frequencies used for the 800MHz Radio Communication System as mandated by FCC
- Reprogramming separates public safety frequencies from commercial providers
- Approximately 4,531 radios and infrastructure will be reconfigured
- Sprint Corporation Amendment No.5 – Next step in project

Amendment No. 5 Summary

- New updated frequencies scanned and reviewed for zero interference
- Settlement agreement for last phase of the project and the revised number of radios
- Settlement amount provides the City funding to complete the project without Sprint

Amendment No. 5 Summary

- System acceptance timeline increased to 90 days
- Revised schedule est. July 2020
- Sprint to provide \$50,000 in contingency funds
- Invoice submittal timeline revised to monthly
- Release of Letter of Credit Line for Sprint required by FCC for the project
