Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that before the bonds are issued, the issuance of such tax exempt bonds must be approved by the highest elected official of the local government unit having jurisdiction over the area in which such facility is located after a public hearing following reasonable notice to the public.

The Industrial Development Authority of La Paz County, Arizona published Notice of Public Hearing in the El Paso Times as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code on May 24, 2018 and held a public hearing on Monday, June 11, 2018.

The plan of finance will be in an amount not to exceed \$85,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be issued as part of the plan of finance and loaned to Charter School Solutions, a Texas Nonprofit Corporation.

WHEREAS, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that before the bonds are issued, the issuance of such tax exempt bonds must be approved by the highest elected official of the local governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which such facility is located after a public hearing following reasonable notice to the public;

WHEREAS, Issuer published a Notice of Public Hearing in the El Paso Times as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code on May 24, 2018, and held a public hearing on Monday, June 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Issuer now requests that the Mayor sign a Certificate of Approval of the Highest Elected Official.

APPROVAL OF THE HIGHEST ELECTED OFFICIAL OF THE ISSUANCE BY THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF LA PAZ COUNTY, ARIZONA EDUCATION FACILITIES LEASE REVENUE BONDS (CHARTER SCHOOL SOLUTIONS) SERIES 2018 FOR PURPOSES OF SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE

WHEREAS, the Industrial Development Authority of the County of La Paz, Arizona (the "Issuer") is a public not-for-profit corporation created pursuant to the provisions of Title 35, Chapter 5, of the Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended (the "Act"), and the Issuer is empowered under the Act to issue bonds to finance educational and housing facilities for open-enrollment charter schools as described in the Act, including facilities owned or operated by a nonprofit organization described in Section 501(c) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the Proposed Regulations thereunder (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the purposes of the Act, the Corporation has authorized the issuance of its revenue bonds designated as the "The Industrial Development Corporation of La Paz County, Arizona Education Facilities Lease Revenue Bonds (Charter School Solutions), Series 2018" (the "Bonds"), the proceeds of which will be loaned to Charter School Solutions (the "Borrower") to be used to finance and refinance the cost of certain educational facilities of the Borrower located in El Paso, Texas;

WHEREAS, Section 147(f) of the Code requires that the issuance of any qualified 501(c)(3) obligations be approved by the "applicable elected representative" (the "AER") of the governmental unit in which the Project, as defined in <u>Exhibit A</u>, is located after a public hearing following reasonable public notice;

WHEREAS, the Bonds are qualified Section 501(c)(3) obligations under the Code;

WHEREAS, the Project is located in the City of El Paso, Texas (the "City"), and the City Council ("City Council") is an AER for the City;

WHEREAS, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> is the Certificate of Public Hearing Officer; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto and included in the Certificate of Public Hearing Officer is the Notice of Public Hearing which was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, as required by Section 147(f) of the Code which public hearing was conducted by the Corporation on June 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto and included in the Certificate of Public Hearing Officer is the Affidavit of Publication of the Notice of Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the Project and the Bonds solely for purposes of satisfying the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the actions of the City Council with respect to the Project and the Bonds and to the matters described herein will create no liability for the City and is in the best interest of the City, and the City Council desires to approve this Resolution;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO THAT:

The City Council hereby specifically approves the Bonds and the Project solely for the purpose of satisfying the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Code and such approval is not to be construed as an undertaking by the City. The Bonds shall not constitute a liability, an indebtedness or an obligation of the City nor shall any of the assets of the City be pledged to the payment of the Bonds. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the execution hereof.

Charter School Solutions is requesting your approval of a proposed tax-exempt bond issue, as required by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). The bonds will not be a debt or liability of the City of El Paso, Texas (the "City"). The consent being requested herein is only for the purposes of complying with federal tax law regarding tax-exempt financing.

Charter School Solutions is a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization, and therefore is eligible to participate in tax-exempt financings. However, unlike a governmental issuer (e.g., a city, county, or school district), a 501(c)(3) organization must issue bonds through a state-approved conduit and must conduct a public hearing on the financing. Code §147(f) requires that the "highest elected official" of the City approve the transaction after the public hearing is held because two of the campuses will be located in the City. The public hearing was held on June 11, 2018, at 9405 Betel Dr., El Paso, Texas 79907.

Charter School Solutions is financing the construction and equipment of its schools across the State of Texas. The City campuses that will be financed are located at: (i) 9435 Betel Dr., El Paso, Texas 79907 ('Harmony School of Excellence - El Paso'') and (ii) the intersection of Saul Kleinfeld Drive and Rufus Brijalba Drive, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas 79936. Charter School Solutions is financing at tax-exempt interest rates through a bond issue facilitated by Industrial Development Authority of the County of La Paz, Arizona. Hunton Andrews Kurth LLP serves as bond counsel for the transaction.

As such, we respectfully request your consent to the transaction. Attached is a copy of the Approval Resolution and the completed Certificate of Hearing Officer.
