Discussion and action on a Resolution that the City finds that Alonzo Varela showed a good cause to extend the deadline to apply for a refund of the overpayment of the 2012 property taxes and the tax refund in the amount of \$238.62 is approved.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

A citizen has applied for a tax refund due to overpayment on January 28, 2013. The Property Tax Code states that the Tax Collector may issue a refund "within 3 years of the date of the payment" but that "the governing body of the taxing unit may extend the deadline for a single period not to exceed 2 years on a showing of good cause by the taxpayer.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31.11 (c) of the Texas Code an application for a refund must be made within three (3) years after the date of the payment or the taxpayer waives the right to the refund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31.11 (c-1) the governing body of the taxing unit may extend the deadline for a single period not to exceed two years on a showing of good cause by the taxpayer; and

WHEREAS, taxpayer, Alonzo Varela ("Taxpayer") has applied for a refund with the tax assessor for their 2012 property taxes that were overpaid on January 28, 2013 in the amount of \$238.62 for all taxing entities; and

WHEREAS, City Council may extend the deadline for the Taxpayer's application for the overpayment of the 2012 taxes for a period not to exceed two years on a showing of good cause by the taxpayer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

THAT the City finds that Alonzo Varela showed a good cause to extend the deadline to apply for a refund of the overpayment of the 2012 taxes and the tax refund in the amount of \$238.62 is approved.




