Hidden Valley Park Amenities – \$864,700 (**District #3**): This public facility project, located at 200 Coconut Tree Lane, is added to the 40th Year CDBG program. The project entails installation of a splash pad with 20 to 25 water

features; an accessible parking space; accessible paths to connect to all amenities and other paths; removal of an existing picnic unit; trees with drip irrigation; landscaping and irrigation modifications; and sodding.

The funds for these two projects will be transferred from the CDBG Unprogrammed Funds account.

2. That the City Manager be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution upon approval by the City Attorney's Office and Director of Community and Human Development Department.

Ms. Veronica Soto, Community and Human Development Director, presented a PowerPoint presentation (copy on file in City Clerk's Office).

Mayor Pro Tempore Noe commented on the following:

Mayor Leeser voting on 211 Zoning issues and on need of Charter change.

In regards to public comment, he would like to require that microphone be turned off if the speaker is acting disrespectfully or inappropriately. If the person still continues, Council as a majority can ban the speaker for a period of time.

When placing agenda items by Council, arrange who submits an item and all of Council be notified.

On agenda back-up issues, it must be at the same time of item submittal.

On how to second a motion, go back to the "Shout Out" method.

Rules and consequences for Representatives; to show respect for each other, staff and public.

Mayor Leaser commented on being on time for meetings.

Representative Acosta commented on the following:

Clean up City Chapter Sections 3.5 and Section 7

Allow a maximum of 30 minutes for public comment; need to comply with Section 12.

Mayor to turn microphone off if public speaker is being disrespectful.

Move Call to the Public to Monday at 8:30 a.m.

Representative Svarzbein asked Mayor Pro Tempore Noe how he would legislate respect among City Council members.

Representative Romero commented on a requirement of having three signatures from City Council members to place an item on the City Council agenda.

Mayor Pro Tempore Noe commented that individual Council members can place items on a Special City Council meeting or LRC.

Representative Ordaz agrees with turning off microphone for public speakers out of order or disrespectful and commented on respect toward staff. She also commented on back up and placing items by City Council. Also, when Council places an item, no back up from staff will be required.

Mayor Leaser commented that back up by Council members should be required. He also commented that the word "direct" to staff should not be used.

Representative Svarzbein expressed his concern about public comment on Mondays because no attendance by Council is required. He also finds too drastic to require multiple signatures on agenda since it goes against single member district.

Representative Limón disagrees with three signatures to place items on agenda. She also needs clarification on equality of treatment for all Council members, level playing field. Commented on back up.

Representative Robinson commented that rules should be followed by all Council members.

He disagrees with three signatures for agenda items and commented back up should be required.

He commented that respect should be shown by all Council members to all Council members, staff and the public.

He commented on refining section on Call to the Public and not allow Council to deliberate or derail during Call to the Public.

He mentioned that phrase "Direct City Manager" seems to cause offense depending on who uses it.

Representative Niland agrees with three approvals required for items by Council.

She commented that microphone should be cut off during public comment and to "Voice" motions and seconds.

Regarding public comment and Council interaction, she mentioned she wishes to be able to respond to questions by the public. No pontification.

She commented on civil discourse and the need to avoid talking poorly about one another.

Representative Svarzbein asked what other cities require multiple approvals for placement on agenda by City Council.

Representative Ordaz suggests there is the ability for City Council members to place their own informational item.

Representative Limón commented on paying attention to speakers during call to the public with listening and eye contact.
