

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Texas Transportation Code Chapter 311 grants home-rule municipalities exclusive control over and under the public highways, streets, and alleys of the municipality, including the assigning of street names to highways within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the process for the naming of a state highway within a municipality is set forth in the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT's) Signs and Markings Manual, Chapter 7, Section 18; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT's Signs and Markings Manual requires the municipality enact a resolution or ordinance naming the highway and forward the resolution or ordinance to the TxDOT district office for review of the name; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to make a recommendation that the segment of State Loop 375 from I-10 to State Highway 62/180 Montana Highway be named the "Joseph C. Pickett Expressway" and leave the access roads named "Joe Battle".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City Council recommends that the segment of State Loop 375 from I-10 to State Highway 62/180 Montana Highway be named the "Joseph C. Pickett Expressway"; leave the access roads named "Joe Battle"; and authorizes the City Manager to forward this Resolution to the Texas Department of Transportation for approval of the name and execute any necessary documents to effectuate the adoption of the name and make any budget transfers necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.


