

Purpose of Resolution

- Authorize City Manager to sign Landscape Maintenance Agreement between the City of El Paso and the State of Texas, acting by and through the Texas Department of Transportation
- City agrees to maintain landscape improvements installed by the City as part of the BRIO/RTS Bus Stop Landscaping and Pedestrian Enhancement projects, located on Pershing Dr./Dyer St. and Alameda Ave.
- Agreement will remain in effect until terminated or modified

City Responsibilities

- Maintain all landscape elements including but not limited to trees, shrubs, grass, sidewalks, irrigation, systems and hardscape features
- Maintenance shall include but not limited too plant maintenance & replacement, mowing and trimming, hardscape maintenance and irrigation system operation
- Follow TXDoT specifications and standards
- Maintain all landscape elements within limits of right of way excluding paved areas intended for vehicular travel
- City shall be responsible for all utility costs associated with maintenance



Resolution 19-1050-3285 Landscape Maintenance Agreement

State Responsibilities

- Allow City and its agents to utilize the right of way for all aspects of BRIO/RTS project
- Coordinate with City to define limits of maintenance as made as part of this agreement
- Coordinate with City landscape maintenance operations for consistency with District Policy
- Approve Traffic Control Plan
