# BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

Council approved the Local Project Advanced Funding Agreement (LPAFA) for the Alabama Street Bridge Replacement project on February 26, 2019 along with three other LPAFA's for bridge reconstruction (Davis, Delta, and Yarbrough). The Alabama and Davis bridge LPAFA's are being amended to allow the City to manage the reconstruction of the bridges, consistent with the LPAFA agreements for Delta and Yarbrough bridges.
