What the City is Doing to Save You Money


- Investing strategically to save the community money
- Identifying savings or efficiencies through performance excellence initiatives
- Providing free or reduced services for kids and seniors

City Property Tax Exemptions

- The City provides over \$19.2 million in property tax discounts (homestead exemptions)
- Equivalent to 6 cents on the tax rate
- Homestead Exemption
 - 126,689 homesteads benefit from a \$5,000 discount
- Over 65/Disabled Homestead Exemption
 - To promote the general welfare of senior and disabled citizens
 - 47,772, or almost 40% of the total homesteads, benefit from a \$40,000 discount


Regional Economic Development Strategy

- Financial benefit to the other taxing entities, 74% of the tax bill, is projected to be \$214 million (over a 20 year period)
- \$1.59 billion in capital investment
- 12,114 jobs created or retained
- No longer listed as an "economically distressed community" by the Texas Workforce Commission



Flood Zone Investments

- Removed approximately 4,876 of 6,532 parcels from the flood zones as a result of El Paso Water Utilities improvements
- District 2 & 4 homeowners will save \$9 million
- Average savings of \$782 per homeowner
- Savings are realized by lowered or eliminated flood insurance policies
- The investments may increase property values and provide more marketable resales



Fire Department – ISO Class 1

- The El Paso Fire Department is one of only 238 accredited fire departments in the world, and one of 241 in the country with an Insurance Services Organization (ISO) Public Protection Classification 1.
- El Paso is one of 5 agencies which are both Internationally Accredited and ISO Class 1 serving a population greater than 500,000.
- Result El Paso residents and businesses have lower property insurance rates
- Average annual savings of \$300

Free or Reduced Fees for Seniors

- Zoo discount on entrance fee
- Sun Metro discounted single or multiple ride passes
- Museums membership fee discount to Art, History, and Archaeology museums
- Parks
 - \$1 discount on public swim
 - 50% Discount on monthly or yearly fees Leisure Interest Classes, Racquetball Courts, Weight Room, Billiards, Boxing
- Garbage collection 20% discount

Additional Services for Seniors

- Community Development programs
 - Foster Grandparent program Connects senior volunteers with at-risk and special needs youth in El Paso
 - Retired and Senior Volunteer program brings the life experience of over 500 El Pasoans age 55 and older to agencies and organizations across El Paso County
 - CDBG
 - Making El Paso a great place for seniors and persons with disabilities to choose to live here
 - Provide safety net services such as meal programs, adult day care, adequate shelter and other services that promote independence and accessibility.

Free or Reduced Fees for Kids

- Parks
 - Discounts on multiple child program registration
 - High speed internet and Wi-Fi
 - New playgrounds
 - 8 spray parks and upcoming neighborhood water parks
 - Celebration of Lights
- Libraries
 - Dia de Los Niños
 - Teen Zones
 - Increased free computer access
 - Digital books and magazines
 - Increased participation in Online High school





Free or Reduced Fees for Kids

- Museums
 - Chalk the Block
 - Discounts for classes, art camps, workshops
- Sun Metro
 - Free summer youth passes through August
 - Student discounts
- Community Development
 - After-school programs, gang prevention activities, drug awareness and treatment projects, specialized services for foster children, court advocacy, and supportive services
 - Licensed childcare, diverse education, recreation, community improvement and physical and mental health programs
