BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The City of El Paso is holding the first of two public hearings to discuss the property tax rate introduced on July 28, 2016. Texas Tax Code § 26.05(d) requires at least two public hearings before the adoption of an ordinance levying taxes, if the proposed tax rate exceeds the lower of the rollback rate or the effective tax rate. Texas Tax Code § 26.06 provides that the first hearing may not be held before the seventh day after the date the notice of the public hearing is given. Notice of the public hearings was given on Friday, July 29, 2016, a date more than seven days before August 9, 2016.
