INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER (Laboratory Testing Services)

This Interlocal Agreement is entered into and effective on the latest date reflected on the signature pages at the end of this Agreement, by and between the City of El Paso, Texas ("CITY"), a Texas Municipal Corporation, and the El Paso County Hospital District d/b/a University Medical Center of El Paso ("UMC"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Art. 791.001, *et seq.*, Texas Government Code. CITY and UMC are collectively referred to the Parties in this Agreement.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code authorizes local governments, special districts and other political subdivisions of this state, including the CITY and UMC, to contract with each other to perform governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS, the CITY's Public Health Department performs the governmental function of various medical laboratory testing to ensure and improve the health and well-being of the citizens of El Paso through various programs; and

WHEREAS, UMC operates and maintains University Medical Center; which provides medical services in the community; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and UMC both provide laboratory testing services and desire to share such services for the purpose of reducing duplication of services in the regional area and provide potential savings for both parties; and

WHEREAS, the Parties each agree to accept the responsibility to adhere to all pertinent federal, state and local laws or regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize that this Agreement to share laboratory testing services would improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the parties' respective governmental entity.

NOW THEREFORE, be it known that the CITY and UMC enter into this Interlocal Agreement under the following terms and conditions:

1.0 CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP.

1.1 The Parties to this Agreement are local governmental entities that are entering into this contract pursuant to Chapter 791, Texas Government Code, which establishes the legal relationship between the parties. No other legal relationship is intended to be created by this Agreement, to include but not be limited to landlord-tenant, employer-employee, or principal-agent. No provision of this Agreement that imposes an obligation or restriction on either party not permitted by applicable law shall be enforceable.

1.2 UMC acknowledges and agrees that it does not have, and will not attempt to assert, the authority to make commitments for or to bind the CITY to any obligation other than the obligations set forth in this Agreement. The CITY also acknowledges and agrees that it does not have, and will not attempt to assert, the authority to make commitments for or to bind UMC to any obligation other than the obligations set forth in this Agreement.

2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES.

2.1 The Parties acknowledge and expressly agree that, in all things relating to this Agreement, the CITY and UMC are performing governmental functions, as defined by the Texas Torts Claims Act. The Parties hereby agree that the CITY and UMC enter into this Agreement as governmental entities for the purpose of performing a governmental function.

2.2. The CITY and UMC agree to provide laboratory testing services when requested by the other party; as listed in Appendix "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein. The Parties may enter into agreements with third parties to provide the services under this Agreement. The Director of the City's Public Health Department or a designee shall establish a system that will address ability and capacity to include intake, expected timeframe and types of services, which will be available to UMC.

2.3 UMC agrees to process the CITYs request for esoteric testing by using Quest Diagnostic Laboratories at UMC's cost plus a \$5.00 handling fee.

2.4 Ownership of specimens shall transfer to the testing party upon receipt of specimens.

2.5 Preferences for the transmission of reporting shall be in the following order: electronic form, fax, courier or mail. Critical values, as defined by each laboratory, shall be telephoned for a person-to-person report. For privacy purposes, reporting will not include voicemail.

2.6 Appropriately safeguard individually identifiable health information and perform all responsibilities under the Business Associate Agreement, herein referenced and incorporated herein as Appendix "B".

3.0 CONSIDERATION

3.1 The Parties will reimburse each other for services rendered according to the following fee guidelines.

3.2 The City will provide the County an updated fee schedule by September 1st of each year. The County will provide the City an updated fee schedule by August 1st of each year.

3.3 As deemed necessary by either party, additions and deletions of tests to the menu of services may take place at any time in consideration of the potential for mid-year additions of new tests or methodologies and/or discontinuation of existing tests or methodologies.

3.4 The Parties agree that upon presentation by the other party of a properly documented proof of performance and invoice, each party shall make full payment to the other party within thirty (30) days of the delivery of the invoice. Invoices will be sent on a monthly hasis. Payments not made when due shall be subject to late charges of the lesser of (a) one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month of the overdue amount or (b) the maximum amount permitted under applicable law. Both parties agree that the said sum for the services rendered during the term of this Agreement shall not exceed \$80,000.00 annually.

4.0 TERM.

4.1 This Interlocal Agreement shall be in effect for one year from the effective date. This Interlocal Agreement shall thereafter automatically renew for a maximum of four (4) successive one (1) year periods, unless terminated by either party in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.0, below.

5.0 TERMINATION

5.1 <u>Termination by Mutual Consent</u>. The parties may terminate this Agreement by mutual consent upon such terms as they may agree in writing. Except as otherwise provided herein, all duties and obligations of the City and the UMC shall cease upon termination or expiration of this Agreement.

5.2 <u>Termination by Either Party</u>. The CITY or UMC may cancel this Agreement at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice via certified mail, return receipt requested. The obligations of the parties, including each party's obligations to pay for all costs incurred under this Agreement prior to such cancellation notice, shall survive such cancellation until performed.

5.3 To the extent that either party is wholly or partially prevented from performance of any obligation or duty placed on it pursuant to this Agreement, by reason of strikes; stoppage of labor; riot; fire; flood; earthquake; acts of war; insurrection; accident; judgment; act of God; or other cause reasonably beyond the party's control, in such event the time and performance of such obligation or duty shall be suspended until such disability to perform is removed.

6.0 GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION AND IMMUNITY.

6.1 <u>Governmental Function</u>. The CITY and UMC expressly agree that, in all things relating to this Agreement, the parties enter into this Agreement for the purpose of performing governmental functions and are performing governmental functions, as defined by the Texas Tort Claims Act. The parties further expressly agree that every act or omission of each party, which in any way pertains to or arises out of this Agreement, falls within the definition of governmental function.

6.2 <u>Sovereign Immunity</u>. The CITY and UMC reserve, and do not waive, their respective rights of sovereign immunity and similar rights and do not waive their rights under the Texas Tort Claims Act. The parties expressly agree that neither party waives, nor shall be deemed hereby to waive, any immunity or defense that would otherwise be available to it against claims arising in the exercise of its powers or functions or pursuant to the Texas Tort Claims Act or other applicable statutes, laws, rules, or regulations.

7.0 RISK ALLOCATION – LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

7.1 <u>Liability</u>. This Agreement is not intended to alter or real locate any defense or immunity authorized or available to either party by law.

7.1.1 Exclusion of Incidental and Consequential Damages. Independent of, severable from, and to be enforced independently of any other enforceable or unenforceable provision of this Agreement, neither party shall be liable to the other party (nor to any person claiming rights derived from such party's rights) for incidental, consequential, special, punitive, or exemplary damages of any kind - including lost profits, loss of business, and further including, mental anguish, emotional distress and attorneys' fees- as a result of breach of any term of this Agreement, regardless of whether the party was advised, had other reason to know, or in fact knew of the possibility thereof, except as expressly provided herein. Neither party hereto shall be liable to the other party or any third party by reason of any inaccuracy, incompleteness, or obsolescence of any information provided or maintained by the other party regardless of whether the party receiving said information from the other party was advised, had other reason to know, or in fact knew thereof.

7.1.2 <u>Intentional Risk Allocation</u>. The CITY and UMC each acknowledge that the provisions of this Agreement were negotiated to reflect an informed, voluntary allocation between them of all risks (both known and unknown) associated with the transactions associated with this Agreement. The disclaimers and limitations in this Agreement are intended to limit the circumstances of liability. The remedy limitations, and the limitations of liability, are separately intended to limit the forms of relief available to the parties.

7.1.3 <u>No Indemnification</u>. The parties expressly agree that, except as provided herein, neither party shall have the right to seek indemnification or contribution from the other party for any losses, costs, expenses, or damages directly or indirectly arising, in whole or part, from this Agreement.

7.1.4. <u>Fines and Penalties.</u> Each party shall be solely responsible for fiscal penalties, fines or any other sanctions occasioned as a result of a finding that violations of any applicable local, state or federal regulations, codes or laws occurred as a result of that party's actions, except as may be specifically provided by law.

8.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

8.1 <u>Compliance with Laws</u>. In the performance of their obligations under this Agreement, the parties shall comply with all applicable federal, state or local laws, ordinances and regulations.

8.2 <u>Governing Law.</u> This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, along with any applicable provisions of the federal law, the City Charter and/or any ordinance of the CITY.

8.3 <u>Venue</u>. The parties hereto agree that this Agreement shall be enforceable in El Paso, Texas, and if legal action is necessary to enforce it, exclusive venue shall lie in El Paso County, Texas. Should the need for dispute resolution arise, venue is in the El Paso County, Texas.

8.4 <u>Current Revenues.</u> Pursuant to Section 791.011(d)(3), Texas Government Code, each party paying for the performance of governmental functions or services will make those payments from current revenues available to the paying party.

8.5 <u>No Waiver</u>. The failure of either party at any time to require performance by the other party of any provision of this agreement shall in no way affect the right of such party to require performance of that provision. Any waiver by either party of any breach of any provision of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of any continuing or succeeding breach of such provision, a waiver or the provision itself, or a waiver of any right under this Agreement.

8.6 <u>Amendment; Assignability</u>. This Agreement and the obligations hereunder shall not be amended, assigned, transferred or encumbered, in any manner without the written consent of the other party.

8.7 <u>Severability.</u> All agreements and covenants contained in this Agreement are severable. Should any term or provision of this Agreement be declared illegal, invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Agreement will not be affected; and in lieu of each provision which to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, there will be added as part of this Agreement, a provision which preserves the intention of the unenforceable provision, but which complies with the law.

8.8 <u>Section Headings.</u> The paragraph or section headings contained in this Agreement are for reference purposes only and shall not in any way control the meaning or interpretation of this Agreement.

8.9 <u>Representation of Counsel; Mutual Negotiation.</u> Each party has had the opportunity to be represented by counsel of its choice in negotiating this Agreement. This Agreement shall therefore be deemed to have been negotiated and prepared at the joint request, direction, and construction of the parties, at arms' length, with the advice and participation of counsel, and will be interpreted in accordance with its terms without favor to any party.

8.10 <u>Notices.</u> Any notice, demand, request, consent or approval that either party may or is required to provide to the other, shall be in writing and either personally delivered or sent via United States Postal Service certified mail return receipt requested, addressed to the other party at the following address(es) provided below:

Changes may be made to the above addresses and addressees through timely written notice provided to the other party.

8.11 <u>Execution and Counterparts.</u> This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts; each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed an original, and such counterparts together shall constitute only one instrument. Any one of such counterparts shall be sufficient for the purpose of proving the existence and terms of this Agreement and no party shall be required to produce an original or all of such counterparts when making such proof.

8.12 <u>Complete Agreement.</u> This Agreement supersedes any and all other agreements, either oral or in writing, between the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof, and this Agreement, together with any Attachment(s) attached hereto, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties relating to the terms and conditions of the Agreement. The parties expressly acknowledge and warrant that there exists no other written or oral understanding, agreements or assurances with respect to such matters except as are set forth herein. Unless expressly stated, this Agreement confers no rights on any person(s) or business entity(s) that is not a party hereto.

8.13 <u>Warranty of Capacity to Execute Contract.</u> The person signing this Agreement on behalf of each party warrants that he/she has the authority to do so and to bind each party to this Agreement and all the terms and conditions contained herein.

8.14 <u>Independent Contractor</u>. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as creating the relationship of employer and employee between UMC and CITY, insofar as UMC will not direct CITY in the performance of its services or in any manner interfere with the professional judgment of CITY. CITY shall be deemed at all times to be an independent contractor. CITY shall not be included in any employee retirement or fringe benefit plan, and will not be covered by Worker's Compensation Coverage. UMC will not withhold monies for State or Federal Income Tax or Social Security Payments, and the fees stipulated herein shall be paid in full to CITY without deductions of any kind. CITY shall be responsible for payment of Social Security and State and Federal Income Taxes.

8.15 Funding. This Agreement is conditional upon, subject to and contingent upon funding being available for the term in question and neither party shall have cause of action against the other in the event that one party is unable to perform its obligation under this Agreement as a result of suspension, termination, withdrawal or failure of funding. In the event that CITY or UMC shall not obtain funding, this Agreement shall be terminated. However, each party shall remain obligated to pay the other party for all services rendered prior to the effective date of notice of termination. In the event that the CITY or UMC does not include sufficient funds in its budget for any fiscal year during the term of this Agreement, for the payment of its obligations hereunder, the CITY or UMC may terminate this Agreement without penalty or further payment, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

8.16 Access to Records. Pursuant to Public Law 96-499, sec. 952 (Sec. 1861 (v)(1) of the Social Security Act), the parties agree that: the Parties shall, until the expiration of four (4) years after the furnishing of the services under this Agreement, retain and make available, under written request by the secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, or upon written request, by the U.S. Comptroller General, or any of their duly authorized representatives, the contract and books, documents and records of either party that are necessary to verify the nature and extent of the cost of the services under this Agreement. If either of the Parties carry out any of the duties of this Agreement through a subcontract, with a value or cost of \$10,000.00 or more over a twelve (12) month period with a related organization, such subcontract shall contain a clause to the effect that, until the expiration of four (4) years after the furnishing of such services pursuant to such subcontract, the related organization shall retain and make available, upon written request by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, or upon written request by the U.S. Comptroller General, or any of their duly authorized representatives, the subcontract and books, documents or records of such organization that are necessary to verify the nature and extent of such costs of the subcontracted services. In the event of a request for access, Both Parties agree to notify the other what response will be made to that request.

8.17 <u>HIPAA Requirements</u> the City and UMC, their employees, officers and directors agree to comply with the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act of 2009 ("HITECH") and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, as codified at 42 U.S.C. § 1320d ("HIPAA"). The Parties agree not to use or further disclose any Protected Health Information (as defined in 45 C.F.R. Section 164.501) or Individually Identifiable Health Information (as defined in 42 U.S.C. Section 1320d), other than as permitted by HIPAA, HITECH and the terms of this Agreement. The Parties will make their internal practices, books, and records relating to the use and disclosure of Protected Health Information available to the Secretary of Health and Human Services to the extent required for determining compliance with HIPAA and HITECH.

8.18 <u>Compliance</u>. Both Parties represents and warrants that it shall not contract with any individual(s) or entity that is excluded from participation under the Office of Inspector General ("OIG") or any other governmental program. Each Party shall notify the other party or any individual immediately in the event that the notifying party, or any individual(s) it contracts with, is excluded from participating under the OIG or any other governmental program. Each party represents and warrants that neither it nor its employees, agents, or assigns have been (a) convicted of a criminal offense related to healthcare (unless such person or entity has

implemented a compliance program as part of an agreement with the federal government); or (b) listed by a federal agency as debarred, excluded or otherwise ineligible for federal program participation under 42 U.S.C. 1320a-7, the OIG List of Excluded Individuals/Entities and/or the General Services Administration ("GSA") list of debarred contractors. Each party shall notify the other party within three (3) days of the time it receives notice of any action being taken against it or its employees, agents, or assigns which could result in the notifying party's exclusion from participating in the Federal health care programs. Each party acknowledges that the other party may terminate this Agreement without penalty or further payment upon the resolution of a pending criminal charge or proposed disbarment or exclusion which results in a conviction, disbarment or exclusion of either party or its employees, agents, or assigns.
